



## LMBA All Star Program Guidelines (2009)

The intent of this initiative is to ensure that the house program does not subsidize the All Star program, improve the quality of All Star uniforms and equipment, simplify the efforts by All Star teams to organize and operate their team, standardize All Star operations at each division and ensure sufficient registration fees to sustain quality uniforms and equipment. The All Star guidelines are as follows:

- The Division Managers will provide the registrar with the names of their All Star coaches and associated teams. The All Star team coaches will need to provide the registrar their rosters. The coaches (or the parents) will need to provide the registrar with the team registration fees and their uniform deposits.
- No uniform will be handed out until the registration fee and the uniform deposit have been received. And there can be no outstanding house (spring) ball fees
- Uniform Cheques of \$125.00 will be postdated to September 1<sup>st</sup> 2009 and made payable to Ladner Minor Baseball Association (this goes for the coaches also).
- The registration fee amount is based on the cost of BCMBA registration fees, Provincial tournament fees, hats, baseballs and an estimate of the annual cost of wear and tear on uniforms and equipment.
- The fees for each division are as follows:
  - Tadpole \$145 per player
  - Mosquito and Peewee \$155 per player
  - Bantam and Midget \$175 per player
- Each player will be provided:
  - 2-All Star jerseys Home/Away (Must be returned)
  - All Star pants (Must be returned)
  - Belt (Must be returned)
  - Pro-Fit hat (To be kept by player)
  - Socks (To be kept by player)
  - All Star T-shirt (To be kept by player)
- The following expenses will be paid for by the LMBA All Star Program:
  - BCMBA All Star registration fee
  - Umpires
  - BCMBA Provincial Tournament registration fee
  - Baseballs (24)
  - One Tournament
- Concession stands will be operated as they are during the house season. The Concession Manager will coordinate supply, opening and cash handling. Teams will be required to provide volunteers to run the concessions during their home games. All revenues from the concessions will go to LMBA to support the All Star program.



- Teams are responsible for paying for registration fees for any additional tournaments. Having the All Star program cover the cost of another tournament would have increased registration fees. It is left to teams to pay for additional tournaments based on the number and costs of the tournaments they choose to enter.
- Teams are responsible for coordinating umpires for their home games as per past practice, but the All Star program will pay for the umpires.
- The BC Minor Team Registration form can be found on the BC Minor Baseball website at <http://www.bcminorbaseball.org/forms.htm>. This needs to be signed by the President and submitted to BC Minor prior to All Star play and a copy is also required for Tournaments and Provincials. Details will be provided at your Divisional All Star Coaches meeting.
- Teams may keep the revenue from any 50/50 draws they choose to run.
- If a single team wishes to run a tournament, all tournament fees and revenue will go to that team and any expenses paid by that team. Concession revenue will go to LMBA. The team will provide financial statements as to profit/loss of such tournament at the end of the season.
- Teams Qualifying for any Post Provincial events. It will be up to the executive as to how much funding (if any is available) the team will receive.
