## National Sport Summit 2009

### GENERAL INFORMATION

Petro-Canada Sport Leadership sportif is an annual conference organized by the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC) that fosters the development of Canada as a leading sport nation and reinforces CAC's role in achieving that goal. The 2009 conference will be held in Vancouver, November 12-15.

One of the world's premier annual conferences for sport leaders, over 750 coaches, sport administrators, coach educators, and sport scientists will convene for several days of learning, networking, and celebrating achievements.

This year's conference will also include the **International Council for Coach Education (ICCE) Global Coach Conference** which will bring together coaches and coach educators, researchers and sport scientists, technical directors, and sport administrators to address issues in coaching, to learn about new coaching research, and to share experiences with the top coaching development experts in the world. The ICCE Global Coach Conference is held every second year, in the Olympic city before the Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The success of the Petro-Canada Sport Leadership sportif conference can be attributed to the collaboration of sport partners from more than 50 different organizations that participate in the conference as expert presenters or that facilitate parallel meetings.
